Bio



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A **Bit-Tuner** live show means heavy beats, blown up bass sounds, gloomy atmospheres, acid-driven melodies and uproaring soundscapes. His musical field of expression reaches from HipHop Beats to Electronica, Noise, theater productions and film soundtracks.

In his energy-driven concerts, **Bit-Tuner** oscillates between Downbeats, Electronica and lowrider Techno, while he pulls his tracks together to become a gloomy, but still euphoric bass monster. He has shared the stages with Acts like Kelp, Jon Hopkins, Ben Frost, Modeselektor, Shackleton, Jimi Tenor, Zomby or Actress.

Bit-Tuner has collaborated with and / or remixed various rappers like Bleubird (Florida), Oddatee (Deadverse Rec.), Sole (Anticon) or Sensational (WordSound/NYC), Filewile (Mouthwatering Rec.), Omega Takeshi (88:Komaflash), Audio88 (Berlin).

In his work, **Bit-Tuner** likes to push his borders and reinvent himself. Be it in his own music, or while working on soundtracks for film and theatre. In 2015, he collaborated with Extraterrestrial researcher Philipp Theisohn to create the text and sound based narrative performance «Alien Nightlife». He is also a regular live act for runway shows of designers like Julian Zigerli at Mercedes Benz Fashion Weeks in Berlin and Zurich, or Berek's New York Fashion Week Show.

His continuous work is widely recognized, which led to him being shortlisted for the renowned Swiss Music Prize in 2015, alongside artists like Bruno Spoerri, Joy Frempong (OY), Joke Lanz and Nik Bärtsch.
